
Strategic Advantage / 策略優勢





Challenges in Business / 商務挑戰

Intense Local Competition / 激烈的當地競爭

Local businesses have a strong presence and can pose fierce competition. / 本地企業存在強大的競爭力,可能構成激烈的競爭。

Language Barriers in Business Communication / 商業溝通中的語言挑戰

Language differences can hinder effective communication in business. / 語言差異可能會阻礙商業上的有效溝通。

Regulatory and Bureaucratic Hurdles / 相關法規和程序的挑戰

Navigating local regulations and bureaucratic processes can be challenging. / 應對當地法規和政府程序可能具有挑戰性。

High Cost of Living and Business Operations / 較高生活和營運成本

Costs associated with living and doing business in Japan can be high. / 在日本生活和經營業務所需的成本可能很高。

Success #1: On-Time / 成功要素 #1: 準時



在日本,準時被高度重視,而準時到達被認為是尊重和責任的象徵。如果你遲到了,及早告知對方並誠摯道歉是非常重要的。

In Japan, punctuality is highly valued and being on time is considered a sign of respect and responsibility. If you're running late, it's important to let the other person know as soon as possible and apologize sincerely.

遲到的後果在日本可能很嚴重,特別是在商業場合。遲到可能損害你的聲譽和你與同事或客戶的關係。它也可能給他人帶來不便和干擾,這被認為是一種嚴重的禮儀問題。

The consequences of being late in Japan can be serious, especially in business settings. Being late can damage your reputation and your relationship with your colleagues or clients. It can also cause inconvenience and disruption to others, which is considered a serious breach of etiquette.



Key Success #2: Business Conduct / 成功要素 #2: 商務禮節

When exchanging business cards in Japan, it's important to follow these etiquette rules:

- Present your card with both hands, holding it at the corners so that the recipient can read it easily / 雙手握住名片的兩側,以便 對方可以輕易地閱讀
- Bow slightly as you hand over your card / 遞交名片時要略微鞠躬
- Receive the other person's card with both hands, and take a moment to read it carefully / 用雙手接收對方的名片,並花些時間仔細閱讀
- Make a comment or ask a question about the person's card to show interest and respect / 評論或詢問對方的名片,以表現出興趣和尊重
- Store the card in a cardholder or wallet, rather than in your pocket or bag / 將名片放在名片夾或皮夾中,而不是放在口袋或包裡
- Avoid writing on the card or putting it away until the meeting is over / 不要在名片上寫字或收起名片,直到會議結束為止

Culture Attention / 文化上的注意事項

1 Importance of Experty Passing and Respect / 經驗傳承和尊重的重要性

Understanding and respecting experience and experty are crucial in business dealings. / 在商業交易中,理解經驗及專業在商務探討過程的重要。

Indirect Communication Style / 間接的溝通 風格

Japanese business culture often relies on indirect communication methods. / 日本商業文化常常依賴間接的溝通方法。

2 Emphasis on Long-term Relationships and Trust / 長期關係和信任的重視

Building long-term relationships and trust is essential to successful business partnerships. / 建立長期關係和信任對於成功的商業合作夥伴關係至關重要。

4 Traditional Business Etiquette and Practices / 傳統的商業禮節和實踐

Familiarity with traditional business etiquette and practices can greatly influence success. / 熟悉傳統的商業禮節和實踐可以在很大程度上影響成功。

Preparing for Success / 成功的準備

1 當地市場調查 / Local Market Research

進行全面市場調查,了解消費者行為和偏好。 / Conduct comprehensive market research to understand consumer behavior and preferences.

2 建立當地合作夥伴關係 / Establish Local Partnerships

與當地公司建立合作夥伴關係,利用其知識和網絡。 / Establish partnerships with local companies to leverage their knowledge and networks.

9 聘請當地人才或顧問 / Hire Local Talent or Consultants

聘請當地人才或尋求顧問服務,以獲得見解並適應市場。/ Hire local talent or seek consultant services to gain insights and adapt to the market.

根據當地偏好調整產品/服務 / Adjust Products/Services According to Local Preferences
